These documents help trainers, learning organizations and policy makers integrate the learning tool developed by the project team in their training practices. The Training and Policy Adaptation Guides clarify the accreditation method used to develop the learning content, the structure of the learning tool, while overviewing the current initiatives at European level on recognition of skills and qualifications. They also highlight the assessment process included in the SUM e-learning course in order to make it more understandable to trainers and training providers.
