SUM training activity a great success

From 9th May to 13th May, staff members from all SUM partners came together in Nicosia for a joint staff training. We shared the educational resources produced by the project with our organizations' staff and familiarized them with the concept of corporate social responsibility and how it can be applied to start-ups.

Topics included the relationship between CSR and the UN sustainable development goals (SDGs), the role of individual versus organizational values, stakeholder management for start-ups, and others. The participants got to reflect on their own organization's CSR activities, and analyze the CSR policy of well-known enterprises.

To complement the classroom training, a field trip was organized as part of the training activity, giving us all the opportunity to learn how corporate social responsibility is being implemented in the largest and oldest dairy factory in Cyprus.

The philosophy behind the event was to „train the trainers“: to enable staff members to deliver the training developed by SUM to other learners in the future.

The training activity was a great success, as the participants gained valuable insights into CSR for startups, and the SUM project team received feedback for the testing and finalization phases of the project outputs.

Last Intellectual Output under development

The "Training and Policy Adaptation Guide" is a document aimed at helping trainers, learning organizations and policy makers to integrate the SUM curriculum and learning materials into their trainings.

During the course of the project, the SUM consortium has developed high quality training resources that enable learners to gain knowledge about Corporate Social Responsibility and how it can benefit start-ups and small and medium enterprises. Now we want to make sure that these resources can have the most impact possible. Under the direction of CESCOT Veneto, the SUM consortium is developing a training and policy adaptation guide that explains how our resources can be best used in training courses, and integrated into national adult and vocational education schemes.

The guide consists of two parts: the Adaptation, Skills Assessment, Validation and Recognition Guidelines, focusing on how the SUM resources can be used in accordance with current initiatives at European level on recognition of skills and qualifications; and the Policy Guide, containing suggestions for training providers and policy-makers on how to capitalize and make use of the project's results and outputs, as well as recommendations on the use and implementation of training activities using the online tool.

The guide will be finished by October 2022 and made freely available online.
